

Robert Sherber is a South Florida musician that started his musical journey with Bass lessons at the age of 14. By the age of 16 his career as a professional musician was launched, playing Rock n Roll and Blues covers in local venues. Robert attended Dillard School of the Arts and played in the school's prestigious Commercial Music Ensemble. In 2005 Robert became a sideman for legendary TK recording artist Clarence Reid, which led to 6 tours of the United States and Canada, with notable performances at the CMJ Music Conference in New York City and the South by South West music festival in Austin, Texas.

In 2010 Robert was asked to perform alongside Mr. Reid in Australia's largest traveling music festival, the Big Day Out. The festival included stops in Auckland, New Zealand, as well as Brisbane, Sidney, Melbourne, Adelaide, and Perth, Australia. In 2016 Robert earned a Bachelor's degree in Jazz Performance from Florida International University and currently divides his time as a live performer and an instructor of guitar and bass.
